Rudd Labor announces support for local community sporting facilities in Helensburgh

A Rudd Labor Government will provide a contribution of up to \$65,000 to local community sporting facilities in Helensburgh.

Senator Kate Lundy, Shadow Minister for Local Government, Sport, Recreation and Health Promotion and Sharon Bird, Federal Member for Cunningham made the announcement when they visited Helensburgh today.

The commitment includes funding for:

- A lighting upgrade at the Helensburgh Tennis Club (\$15,000);
- Two new netball courts at the Helensburgh netball club for a new summer twilight competition (\$30,000);
- Court resurfacing to improve safety of two courts at the Helensburgh Netball Club (\$13,500); and
- Completion of the new clubhouse at the Helensburgh Netball Club (\$6,500).

"Labor understands the pressures community sporting clubs are under. We want to make sure that they receive the support they need to provide opportunities for our communities to be active," Senator Lundy said.

"We know that sport and recreation plays such an integral part in the social fabric of our community, I am proud to be part of the Labor team that recognises the importance of investing in our local community infrastructure," Sharon Bird said.

"Sharon Bird deserves a great deal of credit for helping to secure this support for these important community assets in Helensburgh," Senator Lundy said.
