\$63,500 to keep local bushfire trails in good working order

The Commonwealth Government will provide \$63,500 to construct, maintain and install signage for bushfire trail networks in the local community, Federal Member for Cunningham, Sharon Bird, said today.

“This funding will enhance the accessibility and effectiveness of the fire trail network, increase the safety of fire fighting volunteers and the speed with which they are able to access any incident of bush fire”, she said.

The fire trail maintenance projects to receive funding under the allocation include:

- Ridge Track, Mt Kembla, \$26,000
- Lower Escarpment, Bulli, \$37,500

This funding has been matched by the New South Wales Government.
